

CAREER AND TECHNICAL PROGRAM MATERIALS LIST

Please review the items either required or recommended for your program. If you do not see your program listed then you are not required to purchase anything.

ADVANCED WELDING AND SHIPFITTING:

Required:

Work Boots (steel or composite toe preferred)
Safety glasses

Recommended:

Welding Gloves
Welding Jackets
Welding Helmet

While these items are provided by the school, it is recommended that students purchase their own because they get sweaty.

AUTOMOTIVE PROGRAM

Required:

Work boots (steel toe or composite preferred)
Safety glasses

Starter Tool Kit (a list of items will be given by the instructor for the student to purchase if he/she would like to purchase tools. If you would like to purchase a starter set from the program, approximate cost \$150, you can inform the instructor.
